
AN ACADEMIC FROM AAU WON ADEK **AWARD FOR RESEARCH EXCELLENCE**

Al Ain University of Science and Technology announced that Dr. Ismail Mabrook, Assistant Professor in the College of Engineering at AAU,has been granted ADEK Award for Research Excellence for the best proposal in Engineering field at the Abu Dhabi level. The award aims to fund outstanding research proposals targeting the strategic priorities of Abu Dhabi.

The idea of the proposal is, to create a machine for early detection of a heart problem or cardiac arrest, so that the device issues alerts to the doctor, so that he will immediately intervene and solve the issue before it occurs.

The research project was evaluated by international evaluators from leading research institutions around the world based on a range of criteria, including the quality of research, relevance and impact, its association with the strategic sectors in Abu Dhabi and the contribution of the project in developing the human resources.
